The Sydney University Rugby League Football Club (SURLFC) has a long and rich history, dating back from its formation in 1920.

Since its formation in 1920, SURLFC has participated in some of the best competitions in rugby league. SURLFC played in Australia's first ever rugby league club competition, the NSW Rugby League Premiership (predecessor to today's NRL) from 1920-1937, most notably finishing runners-up to the South Sydney Rabbitohs in 1926.

Today, SURLFC plays in the NSW Tertiary League, where we field both a first and reserve grade team. With clubs based in Sydney and Canberra, this is a geographically diverse competition conducted by the NSW Rugby League.

We also have an active alumni and a former player group who offer mentorship and support to our players.

The club provides a professional and collegiate atmosphere for student and non-student players to enjoy playing competitive amateur rugby league. We provide our first 50 players with free equipment, gear, playing fields and high level coaches. We provide everything our players need to be the best of the best!


