<u>Schedule</u>

1. Program Recap

- Welcome to Intramural Sporting in 2021. Introduce selves.

- St John's College are leading both the Men's and Women's Competitions after their win at the Touch Football Competition. They are narrowly followed by Regiment and Darlo Bears in both competitions.

2. Updates In 2021

- All residences are expected to have 'uniforms' for their teams. It is preferred that the
 uniforms have numbers on the back for identification purposes. Failure to wear uniforms
 after the above date will resulting a 1-point deduction for both the Male and Female team
 of that residence.
- Sports representatives are expected to reply to all contact within the 3 business days. Failure to do so will result in an attempt to contact them via mobile phone. Should contact still not be made, the Head of Residence will be contacted.

3. Next Sport – Badminton

- Badminton will be held on Saturday 29th May from 12:00pm-4:00pm at the Sports and Aquatic Centre. There will be no orientation.
- Badminton will be run in pools format, which were selected randomly. Each residence will need to provide a squad of a minimum of 6 participants and a maximum of no limit.
- There will be five competitions held throughout the day:
 - Men's Singles
 - o Men's Doubles
 - Women's Singles
 - o Women's Doubles
 - Mixed Doubles.
- Players may choose to play in **any** of the competitions but once a game is started finish that game.
- The singles games will consist of the best of 1 game of 15 points.
- The doubles games will consist of the best of 1 game of 21 points.
- If time permits the finals matches will be the best of 3 games of 15 points for singles and 3 games of 21 points for doubles.
- Rules Games will be following Laws of Badminton as adapted from the "Badminton World Federation".
