LAWS OF THE GAME

TEAM

- Each school/faculty can submit MAXIMUM two (2) teams.
- Each team will have MINIMUM six (6) team members.
- Unlimited numbers of participants are allowed, no extra team participation point will be awarded.
- Three (3) players from an eliminated team can choose to continue their competition with their progressing counterpart from the same school/faculty.

FORMAT

- It is a knockout competition via Zoom and Kahoot!
- All questions are timed.
- Using a PC/laptop is recommended for better reading.
- Please use Team Name as per your represented school/faculty.
- Quiz/Trivia Game PIN(s) will be provided throughout the Trivia.
- The trivia will be played on an honour and honest system, i.e. No googling, No Siri nor asking people who are not in and from your team.
- Each team will assign a captain to submit their answer. (Recommendation: Strong internet connection for captain)
- Team will play their game(s) in a breakout room, so answer can be discussed freely before submission.
- Teams gain the top 4 scoring/positions in the first round will proceed to second round.
- The top 2 scoring teams from second round will go to the final round.
- 3rd and 4th placing points will be awarded to the eliminated team from the second round based on their score in second round.

ETIQUETTE

- Be polite to the trivia host and all participants.
- Contribute your knowledge as best you can to beat the clock.
- Video camera will be on for identify verification.
- Please listen carefully to all instructions.
- To Captain: Have TWO windows open side by side for your easiest reading and answer; one window
 is for question reading by Zoom share screen, one window is for submitting/clicking answer via
 Kahoot!.
