

COVID-19 Changes to SUSF Social Netball Competition

New Game Times

Game times have been altered to include an **additional 5 minutes between games** to assist with equipment and facility cleaning and the safe entry and exit of players. This has resulted in the competition starting slightly earlier than previous competitions.

Sign-In Process

In line with government requirements, **all players are required to record their attendance** each week. To minimise potential transmission of COVID-19, sign-in will **no longer involve pen and paper** and instead will be via **QR code**. All captains have supplied a full list of registered players to the competition.

The SUSF 'COVID-19 Action Plan' and 'Terms & Conditions or returning to SUSAC and Arena during the COVID-19 Pandemic' will be placed around the courts and are available of the SUSF website.

Spectators

To assist with meeting social distancing guidelines, the competition requests NO SPECTATORS attend the competition. If spectators must attend the competition, there is a <u>five-spectator</u> limit per team.

Court Hygiene

In addition to the extensive cleaning practices occurring in all SUSF venues, the Social Netball Competition will:

- Wipe the ball, post pads and frequently touched surfaces with an alcohol-based solution between each game.
- Provide a clean/unworn set of bibs to each team for each game.
- Provide one clean game ball and one ball hygiene ready.
- Provide hand sanitiser at designated entry/exit points and umpire tables.



The SUSF Netball Competition encourages all players to:

- Hand sanitise at the start and end of each quarter
- Do not share water bottles
- Do not share food
- Bring own towel

Entry and Exit of Venue

Teams may only enter the courts 5 minutes <u>prior</u> to their game starting and must leave 5 minutes after their game has concluded. Teams are not permitted to stay in the sports hall once their game has concluded.

Signs will be placed around the centre directing players to exits. Please follow the instructions of umpires, centre staff and court supervisors.

Note: SUSF will not be supplying practice balls or manicure equipment to players.
