

OPERATING RULES

- The event shall be conducted in accordance with both the Constitution, the following by-laws and NSW Cricket Association rules as they are set down for the Sydney District Competition and apply in the year of competition.
- In the case of conflict between the adopted rules and the Constitution or the Sporting By-Laws, the Constitution and Sporting By-Laws shall have over-riding authority.
- 3. The following additional rules are to be adhered to:
 - a. The length of each Innings shall be 50 overs.
 - b. Scheduled play shall occur between 10:00 am and 1:00 pm and from 2:00 pm until the completion of game.
 - Should a fixture end with no result, as defined by the NSW Cricket Association, it shall be replayed after the competition.
 - d. No bowler may bowl more that 10 overs in an innings.

EVENT & VENUE INFORMATION

Alcohol Policy

For matches on St Paul's Oval:

 BYO and consumption of alcohol is NOT permitted on Oval 1, St Paul's Oval, The Square or on/within any other Sydney Uni Sport & Fitness grounds and facilities.

For matches on Andrew's Ovals:

- The incidental service of beer to spectators at Rawson/Rosebowl events on Andrew's Oval is non-contentious in the context of the wider observance of the Intercol Policies on crowd conduct and anti-harassment and on any matter that may bring Colleges of the University into disrepute.
- Intercol and Students' Club representatives of each college are responsible for the serving of alcohol to members of their colleges, the behaviour of those college members to whom alcohol has been served and ensuring compliance with the following restrictions:
 - Individual spectators may NOT bring their own alcohol instead,
 Intercol and Students' Club representatives ONLY may bring alcohol to each event;

- There is to be a single designated point of service for each college participating in a given match, to be clearly marked and situated well away from college administration offices and at the direction of the host College officer or as
- Service of alcohol must conform to RSA guidelines;
- Alcohol provided is to be limited to beer in cans;
- Glass bottles/containers are strictly prohibited;
- Service must cease on instruction from an Officer of the host College; and
- A prompt clean-up of spectator areas is a condition of ground use.
- The host venue reserves the right to cease/deny all service of alcohol at any time if deemed necessary.

Player & Spectator Conduct

- Spectators please remain within the given spectator's area to ensure your own safety, as well as that of players and event staff/officials.
- All players and spectators are expected to abide by the Intercol and Sydney Uni Sport & Fitness codes of conduct. Misconduct will not be tolerated and offending persons may be asked to leave venues immediately and disciplinary action may follow.

Parking

 No parking is available for players and spectators. Vehicles may be used to deliver portable supplies and equipment before/after games.

Rubbish

 All colleges must ensure that each venue is cleared of all rubbish on departure from the premises.

First Aid/Injuries

Ice and first aid kits will be available at each venue. See match
officials (umpires or score bench) for their location. In the event
of a serious injury, please notify Alyssa Hardie, an Intercol rep,
college sports rep, event convenor, or head of college immediately.
