



2016 INTERCOLLEGIATE SPORT REPORT

GENERAL

The 2016 year saw strong athletic achievement and some close and exciting rivalries across both the Rosebowl and Rawson competitions. The Intercollegiate committee worked well together to discuss relevant issues and make necessary procedural changes which assisted in the smooth running of events.

Congratulations to St Andrew's college for their successful Rosebowl and Rawson campaigns, taking both cups back to the college for another year. While Andrew's finished the year ahead there was some great challenges across the board, with St Paul's college contesting strongly in the Rawson. In the Rosebowl Andrews showed their dominance early in the year winning 100% of semester 1 sports. The interesting part of the competition then became to see who would secure second place with positions rotating several times throughout the year. St John's finally taking out 2nd with their first ever win in Rosebowl Athletics.

As well as the regular Rosebowl and Rawson there were a number of social sports elected in 2016 however only social Touch Football proceeded, largely due to a lack of time towards the end of semester. For future years it will be important to discuss and plan dates for social sport early in the year and assign college representatives to ensure the events go ahead and provide additional access to sport for students.

While the culture at various Intercollegiate events in 2016 was at times disappointing it did seem apparent that there was less spectator incidents from previous years with respect to 'banter'. The issues are far from eradicated however the presence and 'reporting in' of senior student representatives did seem to decrease the amount of issues from that seen previously. It is imperative that the committee and colleges continue to provide students with clear guidelines around their expected behaviour and remind them of the importance of the Intercollegiate code of conduct before each event.

In the accounts area, the Intercol committee has finished 2016 with a small surplus in their events accounts. This will be rolled over and taken off the event budget for 2017.

The year was concluded with a successful Intercol Sports Dinner held at St Paul's college. The guest speaker and Paul's ex-student, Alexanda Belonogoff, was able to share his sporting experience both from college and the recent Rio Olympics and no doubt inspire many of the athletes in the room.

Operational changes made to College sporting events in 2016:

- Move of location for Rosebowl Hockey to Kyeemagh to increase access to later afternoon and evening games.
- Senior student asked to be present and responsible for their college's crowd behaviour at Intercol fixtures, particularly final rounds.
- Rosebowl Netball played at SUSAC court 3 & 4 for whole tournament to avoid potential wet weather delays.
- Intercol Committee put together guidelines for MCing at events
 (Rowing/Swimming/Athletics) to assist with more professional commentary.

- Reduced security prescence at Sydney International Rowing Centre due to previous years good behaviour (at SIRC's suggestion).
- Final round of Rawson tennis moved to SUSAC due to wet weather.

Recommendations for 2017:

- Continue to ensure senior student, Intercol representative or responsible allocated student is present from each college and fixtures to monitor their own college's behaviour and comments.
- Ensure any issues with spectators/players/umpires are reported to SUSF representative immediately to allow changes to be made.
- Continue with use of official referees and St John's First Aiders in social sport where required (i.e. contact sports).
- Move Rosebowl Netball to SUSAC courts 1 &2. Spectators can be in grandstand, away from risk of interfering with umpires and in a more controlled environment.
- Possible need for bag checks at Rosebowl Netball final nights as several students were asked to leave SUSF facility due to intoxication.

- Student climbed diving platform and dived off the top despite rules strictly stating not to.

 The current set up is both time wasting, boring for majority of spectators and at times dangerous.
- Get divers to prefill in their dive choices prior to event night to avoid delay

Recommendations

- Clarify disciplinary process when a red card is awarded prior to tournament. This year we
 decided on automatic 1 match ban for red card. Need to look at adjusting constitution to
 reflect this.
- Two conflicting clauses around rescheduling of Rosebowl games (due to wet weather) in the
 Intercol Constitution were disputed. Committee meeting called to discuss. Clause 41.C was
 adopted over Soccer-By-Lay 4.A. Given this choice causes more disruption due to scheduling
 and was also changed for potential wash out in Rosebowl tennis, this needs futher discussion
 amongst committee and edits made to the constitution to improve clarity.
- Rosebowl games were increased to 30 min halves which worked well. Need to adjust constitution to reflect this change so can be held.
- Possibility of moving finals fixtures to evenings to encourage more spectators. This was initially done for 2016 and then changed due to Intercol Committee preferences.
