LOCATION

- St John's College Oval, Sydney University, Camperdown 2050

OPERATING RULES

- The event shall be conducted in accordance with the Australian Rugby Union rules as they apply in the year of competition.
- The following additional rule is to be adhered to:
 - Any player being sent-off or otherwise having been mentioned in the referee's report shall automatically appear before the Intercol Tribunal.
- In the event of wet weather causing closure of the ground, the event will be cancelled.

TEAM

- Teams can have a squad of 14 players, with 12 players eligible to play per game.
- Teams can use unlimited rolling substitutions throughout the entire match, substitutions must occur during breaks in play.
- If a player is injured from College Team 1, players from Team 2 can move up. They cannot then move back down to Team 2.
- If a player from Team 2 is injured, they can bring a suitable replacement in for the remainder of the tournament (except for a player listed in Team 1)
- Teams who make the Grand Final or 3rd Place Play off must keep the same 14 players within their squad.
- All players must be residents at your respective college (no affiliated students)

COMPETITION FORMAT

- 12 teams (2 per college)
- 2 x 7 min halves, 2-minute break.
- 3 Pools of 4 Teams, to all play each other across 3 rounds.
- Top 8 teams across the 3 pools will progress to the final's series.
- Grand Final and 3rd place playoff will be played on 15 May alongside Rawson Rugby Finals.
- Teams not present in a timely manner for the start of a match will result in a forfeit.
- In the event of a tie-on ladder positions, rankings will be based on for and against.
- If a player is shown a yellow card they must leave the field of play for 2 mins, and stay sat in the sinbin.
- If a player is shown a red card, they must leave the field for the remaining duration of match. The player will be suspended for the next game.

OFFICIALS

- A qualified NSWRU Referee will be provided for all matches.
- A member of each competing College shall act as touch judge.
- A member of each competing College shall act as a score official.

EQUIPMENT AND ATTIRE

- A match ball will be provided.
- No equipment is provided for team practice and warm-up. Colleges are expected to bring their own.
- Players are expected to wear appropriate clothing, footwear and protective equipment suitable for Rugby and contact sport.

EVENT & VENUE INFO/CONDITIONS

Injuries, Accidents, Incidents

- In the event of a serious injury, please notify Kirsty Stevens, an Intercol Committee rep, college sports rep, convenor or head of college immediately.

Alcohol Policy

- BYO and consumption of alcohol is NOT permitted at the St John's College Oval.
- Alcohol that is purchased from The Dail may be consumed within the licensed premises ONLY.

Spectators

- All spectators are to remain on the West side of St John's College Oval (closest to the College) the East side remains a players and officials only area for the safety of all players and event staff/officials and spectators.

Parking

- No parking is available on-site for spectators or players.
- Cars may be used to deliver portable supplies before/after games.

Rubbish

All colleges must ensure that the venue is cleared of all rubbish on departure from the venues.

Conduct

- All players and spectators are expected to abide by the Intercol code of conduct. Misconduct will not be tolerated and offending persons may be asked to leave venues immediately and disciplinary action will follow.
- The referees' decision is final.
- Any abuse or misconduct directed at game officials or other players, or on officials' decisions can result in offending players being asked to leave the field.
