- The following additional rules are to be adhered to:
 - Each game shall consist of 2 x 45 min halves fully timed;
 - In the event of a drawn game, each college shall receive one competition point.
 - Colleges can name a squad of 23 players to use throughout the competition.
 - A maximum of 16 players must sign on before play begins
 - A maximum of 5 x player substitutions can be used per game, inclusive of extra time.
 - Players not taking part in the match may not be present in the technical area during matches.

Operating Rules for Rosebowl Cup

- The event shall be conducted in accordance with the Constitution, the following by-laws and FIFA rules as they apply in the year of competition.
- In the case of conflict between the adopted rules and the Constitution or the Sporting By-Laws, the Constitution and Sporting By-Laws shall have over-riding authority.
- The following additional rules are to be adhered to:
 - Each game shall consist of 2 x 35min halves fully timed;
 - In the event of a drawn game, each team will receive one competition point.
 - Colleges can name a squad of 23 players to use throughout the competition.
 - A maximum of 16 players must sign on before play begins
 - A maximum of 5 x player substitutions can be used per game, inclusive of extra time.
 - Players not taking part in the match may not be present in the technical area during matches.

POINT SCORING

- To determine the final result of the competition, the following points shall be awarded for each fixture.
 - A College winning outright shall receive 3 points.
 - In the event of a drawn game, each college shall receive 1 point.
- The final placing shall be awarded according to the aggregate of points accumulated by each College.

ADDITIONAL RULES

- Each competing team MUST provide a scorekeeper for their games.
- All teams should be at the venue at least fifteen minutes prior to their scheduled starting game time.
- Shin pads and safety gear is advised.
- Match balls will be supplied by John's (Rawson) / Sancta (Rosebowl) for each game which MUST be returned to the referee or score bench at the conclusion of every game.

Alcohol Policy

This tournament is a Dry/No BYO event (with the exception of the SUFG). Alcohol is not permitted on the College Ovals at any time. Persons found consuming or in possession of alcohol may be asked to leave the college immediately by Sydney Uni Sport staff, event and/or college staff. Alcohol that is purchased from the SUFG Bar may be consumed within the licensed premises ONLY.

Player & Spectator Conduct
