

## 2020 INTERCOLLEGIATE SPORT REPORT

### GENERAL

---

One poignant moment in particular stands out in my mind as I look back on the Intercol Sport year that was. Watching the Rawson Cup cricket final at St Paul's Oval in a nail-biter of a match between St John's and St Andrew's on a clear, sunny day in March, glancing up to the sky to see a plane writing the following words: "WASH HANDS". I don't think the magnitude of what was coming was understood by anyone at that time.

The next planned event was Rosebowl netball. We were all set to go, then the night before the first fixtures we received the news: All Intercol sport for 2020 is postponed until further notice. By then, the reality of the situation had kicked in. Fast forward to November 2020 and I can proudly report that a year of Rawson and Rosebowl competition has been completed, and as usual it produced stellar performances from all involved.

The presence of COVID meant that modifications needed to be made in order to get through a full program of events. The College Heads collectively decided that in order to fit all sports in, playing times would be halved. When the draft schedule of events was released in May, it seemed like an impossibility to achieve them all. But with hard work, cooperation and some very fortunate weather conditions, SUSF and the Intercollegiate Sports Committee made it happen.

COVID safety plans were drawn up and followed for each venue (internal and external) and for each stand-alone event. Adjusting to the new way of participating in and spectating sport was always going to take some getting used to. But convenors, competitors, external venue hirers and spectators alike approached the situation with maturity and understanding. If there was one positive aspect to come out of COVID, it was the introduction of livestreaming the events. For the first time in the history of the competition, family members and residents alike could tune in and watch the action from the comfort of their homes and common rooms. The initiative was received positively, and will most likely remain a permanent feature of the tournament going forward.

This year the Rawson Cup spoils were shared between the joint winners of St Paul's and St Andrew's Colleges. This tight finish came down to the last event on the sporting calendar in the final rugby match between the two Colleges – a fitting finale to an incredible year. In the Rosebowl competition, the St Andrew's women were again victorious, winning every event except for Tennis. Special mention must be made of the Drew's Women's VIII who set a new Rosebowl course record at the Sydney international Regatta Centre.

Unfortunately, due to COVID restrictions and time restraints, we were unable to facilitate many social sporting events this year. We were lucky enough to fit in the Women's Rugby 7s event which is growing in popularity each year. We will ensure to put a strong focus on bringing the social sport back on the calendar in 2021 through the inclusion of Touch Football, AFL 9s, the All Stars Basketball fixture and, of course, Women's 7s.

I'd like to take this opportunity to thank the Intercol Sports Committee for their hard work this year. 2020 was a challenging year in the world of sports admin, and I'm sure we can all agree that we're happy to bid it farewell. All Committee members should be proud of their stellar efforts in getting the competition up and running. It simply wouldn't have happened without their dedication and cooperation. As always, the SUSF playing fields were in immaculate condition. Thank you also must go to Daryl Davidson and his team of committed grounds staff for providing exceptional playing conditions considering the time constraints.

Despite its setbacks, 2020 has now equipped us all with the skills to accept any challenge head-on with the assurance that we can deliver the best result possible. I'm sincerely looking forward to working with the newly appointed Committee in 2021. I feel that any problems we encounter will seem like a breeze in comparison.

### **Incidents/Recommendations for 2021:**

- We were very lucky with the weather this year. The scheduled “final” date was touch and go all day, with a number of interruptions during play. Fortunately, we were able to get a result.
- From a scheduling perspective, holding the third “final” fixture on Uni #1 Oval would be ideal. It would be regarded as a neutral venue, there is a fully licensed bar in the Grandstand Bar & Grill, and it would be an honor for the participants to experience playing on one of the University’s most prestigious grounds. It is set up to hold more spectators, and overall would be a far greater on-campus experience for all involved.
- For future years I would recommend the changing of any washed-out games to move to T/20 format so that there is less impact on sessions missed. Currently T/20’s are not an option unless agreed on by both captains pending the situation on the day and this becomes time consuming.
