

2022 INTERCOLLEGIATE SPORT REPORT



GENERAL

The 2022 Intercol Sporting calendar resumed to the traditional schedule for the first time since COVID changed the landscape on how the events were delivered. Spectator numbers returned to maximum capacity, and with this came an unprecedented fervour and passion for the prestigious Rawson and Rosebowl tournaments. Despite this, the year didn't unfold without its challenges. Along with some unwelcome National Tertiary Education Union demonstrators at the Soccer Finals, La Nina was the primary 2022 headache that had to be dealt with, bringing record levels of rainfall that affected all outdoor sports to some degree.

Despite the absolute best efforts from the SUSF Grounds Team, we were unfortunately unable to complete this year's Cricket Tournament. Some of the hockey fixtures were played in torrential conditions. St Paul's and St Andrew's Ovals were torn to shreds during the rugby campaign. And by sheer luck, we were just able to get results for both Tennis tournaments with a combination of the Manning Lawn and synthetic Aquatic Centre courts. As with the curveball that COVID threw at us the previous two years, the weather in 2022 tested the adaptability, flexibility and organisational skills of the SUSF Programs team and the 2022 Intercol Sports Committee. As always, I'd like to extend my thanks to the Committee for their patience, assistance and commitment throughout the year. The events simply wouldn't happen without the help of the relative convenors.

Great Big Events (GBE) again provided the livestream gear this year. It needs to be stated that the quality of the livestream service needs to improve. By no means is this a criticism of GBE. They provide state-of-the-art equipment and exceptional troubleshooting customer service. However, the College resident volunteers that operate the equipment need to develop their skills. The commentators have great fun, and provide insightful and humorous content, but the camera operators are unfortunately consistently sub-standard. It goes without saying that this takes away from the viewing experience. The poor camara work also compromises the SUSF brand as it is viewed and archived through the SUSF TV platform. Future Intercol Sports Committees need to incentivise volunteers to do a better job. Alternatively, we can consider outsourcing this responsibility at an additional cost. SUSF firmly believes the livestreaming of Intercol Sport should remain, but the standard must improve. To this end, SUSF has installed a Pixelot camera over the show court which will follow the play for Netball and Basketball next year and can hopefully improve the viewing experience.

Congratulations must go to St Andrew's College for winning the Rawson Cup and Rosebowl competitions this year. Fittingly, St Andrew's hosted the Annual Intercol Sports Awards Dinner after a two-year hiatus, also marking Principal Wayne's Erickson's final year in charge of the sportspeople in sky-blue & white. The silverware collection with Wayne at the helm has certainly been impressive and will no doubt be a hailed as a golden era for St Andrew's Intercollegiate sport. A special mention must also go to the men from St John's College, securing their first trophy in 3 years after winning the Rawson Cup Tennis.

Intercollegiate Social Sport was back on the calendar again in 2022. In Semester 1, St Andrew's College hosted a memorable Women's 7's event to commemorate 20 years of undergraduate women in sport. St John's College then hosted an equally successful Women's 7's competition on their grounds in Semester 2. The male residents enjoyed an Aussie Rules series which saw the final round played under "Friday Night Lights" on Oval #1. While St Paul's and Women's Colleges held a social Touch Football competition day.

2023 promises to be another exciting year as St Paul's College welcomes undergraduate girls into their residential walls and, with that, we expect to see the Rosebowl competition continue to grow in strength and contestability.

- Wesley & St John's College were unable to field a front row for the first 2 rounds, resulting in forfeiting competition points but agreeing to play 15-a-side friendly fixtures.
- SUSF strongly advises that the College Heads meet well in advance of the 2023 tournament to discuss the continuing issues surrounding the safety of scrummaging and being unable to field a suitably trained front row (including reserves).
- Remain a sanctioned event for safety of players and referees.
- Ensure draw is circulated to SUFC well in advance to create a playing schedule that ties in nicely with the Shute Shield draw to maintain player welfare and recovery.
- Crowd control was difficult compared to previous years. May spectators ended up sitting on the steps of the grandstand aisles and ignored instructions to move. SUSF recommends utilising the portable seating on the Eastern side of the ground to help manage this.
- We had one unfortunate verbal incident between two coaches of rival Colleges. This was dealt with by SUSF officials. Having an SUSF official on the field instead of in the grandstand will ensure these situations are dealt with in a more efficient manner.

- As luck would have it, the final round of fixtures coincided with a National Tertiary Education
 Union protest. This caused significant disruption to the final day's play, delaying the fixtures by
 nearly two hours. This delay could have been avoided if the games were scheduled to be played
 on a College-owned ground instead of the SUFG. Something to consider moving forward if we
 are aware of future protests.
- There were several consistent complaints from various Soccer captains regarding the quality of refereeing. SUSF has engaged the same refereeing company for many years. It is probably time to explore the market and source some competitor quotes.
- As per last year, Rosebowl soccer captains requested that their game lengths be the same as the Rawson fixtures. This needs to be discussed and voted upon at the 2023 AGM and a final decision needs to be made by the College Heads.
- As it stands, there are no guidelines surrounding the sanctioning of players receiving red cards.
 SUSF recommends that the College Heads decide how to deal with these instances going forward.
 SUSF recommends that one-match bans should be handed down if a red card is received.
