OPERATING RULES

- The event shall be conducted in accordance with the Inter-College Competitions Memorandum, these by-laws and FIBA Laws of the Game as they apply in the year of competition.
- 2. In the case of conflict between the FIBA laws and these Sporting By-Laws, the FIBA Laws of the Game shall have over-riding authority.
- 3. The following additional rules shall be adhered to:
 - Each game shall consist of four 10-minute quarters, with each quarter fully timed. There shall be intervals of play of two (2) minutes between the first and second quarter, between the third and fourth quarter. There shall be a half-time interval of play of ten (10) minutes.
 - Each match day team can consist of 5 starters, and 7 reserves.
 12 players in total.
 - Each team can have a squad of 16 players to be used for the duration of the competition.
- Any player being ordered-off by the referee shall be required to appear before the Disciplinary Tribunal.

COMPETITION FORMAT

Every College shall play each other according to the draw set out in the Rawson and Rosebowl Rules.

POINT SCORING

- 6. To determine the final result of the competition, the following points shall be awarded for each fixture.
 - (i) The winning College shall receive 2 points
 - (ii) In the event of a tied result at full time, each College shall receive 1 point
 - (iii) The losing College shall receive 0 points
- 7. The final placings shall be awarded according to the aggregate of points accumulated by each College, as outlined in section 2.2 of the Rawson and Rosebowl Rules.

OFFICIALS

- 8. The appointment of suitably accredited Match Officials is the responsibility of Sydney Uni Sport as managers of the competition.
- Two referees with at least level two certification shall officiate at every fixture.
- 10. Three qualified college scorers from a non-participating college shall be present to operate the shot clock, score board and score sheet for the duration of each game.
- A Court Manager shall be employed to oversee proceedings on the night.

DUTIES OF CONVENOR

 The Intercol Sport Competition Manager shall allocate duties in connection with the convenorship of each Rawson and Rosebowl sport.

EVENT & VENUE INFO/CONDITIONS

All matches will take place on Court 1 at the New Balance Stadium at, Sydney University Sports & Aquatic Centre.

Alcohol Policy

The consumption of alcohol is NOT permitted inside the Sydney University Sports & Aquatic Centre (SUSAC). Those found possessing or consuming alcohol will be asked to leave the venue immediately by security, College and/or event staff.

Spectators

Please remain within the given spectator's area to ensure your own safety, as well as that of players and event staff/officials.

Injuries/Accidents/Incidents

Please report all injuries/accidents/incidents to the Sydney Uni Sport staff member or convenor at the event.

A first aider, kit and ice will be available upon request from Sydney Uni Sport staff. In the event of a serious injury/incident, please notify the Sydney Uni Sport staff member or convenor at the event and/ or an Intercol Committee rep, college sports rep, or head of college immediately.

Rubbish

All colleges must ensure that the venue is cleared of all rubbish on departure from the premises.

Conduct

All players and spectators are expected to abide by the Intercol code of conduct and Sydney Uni Sport code of conduct. Misconduct will not be tolerated and offending persons may be asked to leave the venue immediately and disciplinary action will follow.
