## COMPETITION INFO

- The event shall be conducted in accordance with the Constitution, the following by-laws and NSW Hockey Association rules as they apply in the year of competition.
- In the case of conflict between the adopted rules and the Constitution or the Sporting By-Laws, the Constitution and Sporting By-Laws shall have over-riding authority.
- Each game shall consist of two 30 minute halves with a half-time break of 5 minutes, during which teams shall change ends.
- In the case of a draw, each team will be awarded one tournament point for the fixture.

## Rules

- The event shall be conducted in accordance with the Constitution, the following by-laws and NSW Hockey Association rules as they apply in the year of competition.
- In the case of conflict between the adopted rules and the Constitution or the Sporting By-Laws, the Constitution and Sporting By-Laws shall have over-riding authority.
- Each game shall consist of two x 30 min halves with a half-time break of 5 minutes, during which teams shall change ends.
- A warm-up period of 15-minutes on the turf before each game is allowed.
- Teams are allowed a squad of 18 players, but must name 16 players per game
- 11 players on the field, with 5 substitute players

## Points Scoring

To determine the final result of the competition, the following points shall be awarded for each fixture.

- The winning College shall receive 2 points
- Both Colleges shall receive 1 point for a tied match
- The losing College shall receive 0 points

## CONDITIONS
