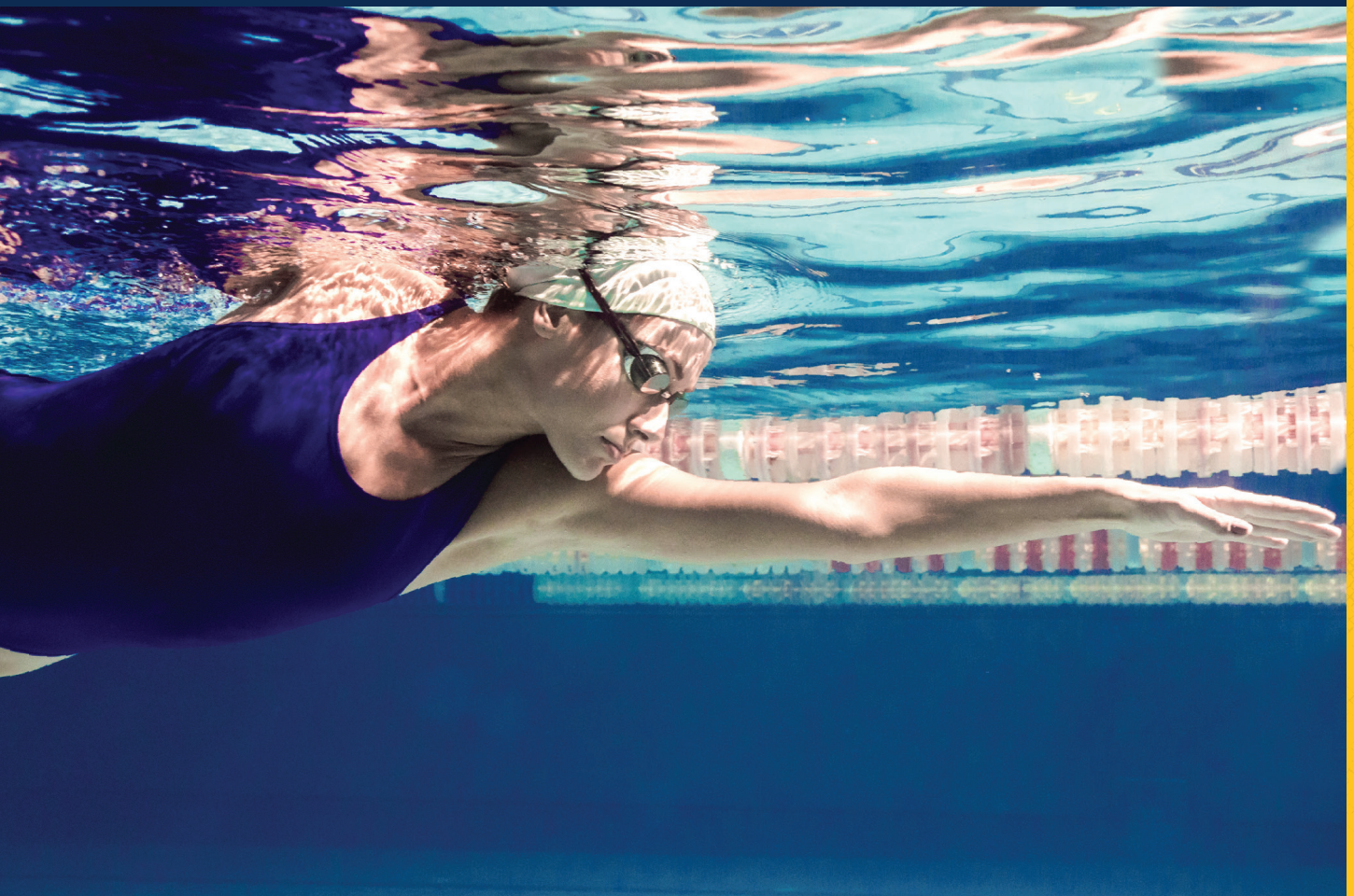

## CARNIVAL & VENUE INFORMATION

### Alcohol policy

This is a Dry/No BYO event Please do not bring alcohol into the venue. Venue and event staff/security reserve the right to check bags and confiscate unsealed bottles on entry to the venue. Persons found consuming or in possession of alcohol within the venue may be asked to leave immediately by security, event and/or college staff.

### No smoking please

Once inside the venue, smoking is strictly prohibited. A number of receptacles are available outside the exit doors on the western side of the complex for smokers.

### Food & beverages

As the venue is fully catered, no commercial food or beverages are to be brought into the Centre.

### Spectators

Please remain within the given spectator's area for your own safety, as well as that of the competitors and event staff/officials.

### Use of diving facilities

NO unauthorised diving is permitted off the diving boards.

### Code of conduct

All competitors and spectators are expected to abide by the Intercol and Sydney Uni Sport & Fitness codes of conduct. Misconduct will not be tolerated and offending persons may be asked to leave the venue immediately and disciplinary action may follow.

### Rubbish

All colleges must ensure that the venue is cleared of all rubbish on departure from the premises.

## OFFICIALS

- The appointment of suitably accredited Officials is the responsibility of Sydney Uni Sport as managers of the competition.
- There should be an accredited Official on each side of the pool, responsible for four lanes each.
- Diving judges should be chosen on the basis of accreditation and impartiality, to avoid bias.
- More than one college should be involved in the scorekeeping to avoid disputes.

## DUTIES OF CONVENOR

The Sydney Uni Sport Manager shall allocate duties in connection with the convenorship of each Rawson and Rosebowl sport.

## COMPETITORS

- The Utility Pool lanes 0–3 only have been reserved for competitors' warm-up and cool-down during the carnival. This area will not be available to swimmers for such purposes during the Diving Championship.
- All competitors are to use the competitors' change rooms between the Competition and Utility pools on the western side of the Centre.
- Sydney International Aquatic Centre's conditions of entry state that "articles of clothing such as street wear, underwear, cut-off jeans, t-shirts, bike pants, leotards, casual wear and sporting wear are strictly prohibited." These rules apply to ALL competitors in EVERY race.
- Competitors must report to the marshalling area for when their event is called.
- Swimming NSW referees will be judging all swimming events and Diving NSW judges will be officiating the Diving Championship.

## OPERATING RULES

1. The event shall be conducted in accordance with the Inter-College.
2. Competitions Memorandum, these by-laws and FINA Swimming Rules as they apply in the year of competition.
3. In the case of conflict between the FINA Rules and these Sporting By-Laws, the FINA Rules shall have over-riding authority.
4. The following additional rules are to be adhered to:
  - A. Each competitor may only compete in a maximum of four individual events and two relays.
  - B. The Diving Championship will consist of each diver attempting three dives, of which no two are from the same group. The groups being:
    - i. Forward
    - ii. Backward
    - iii. Inward
    - iv. Reverse
    - v. Twist
  - C. All dives will be attempted from a 1m springboard.

### Travelling by private vehicle?

Remember to allow ample time for travel to the venue. Peak hour traffic conditions will severely affect travel times. Sydney Olympic Park Aquatic Centre patrons are entitled to park in P2 or P3 and receive 4 hours free parking on production of a validated car park ticket. Your car parking ticket needs to be validated at the Service Desk upon entry into the Aquatic Centre. Once your ticket has been validated, you are entitled to 4 hours free parking. For every hour after 4 hours, the normal casual parking rates of \$5 per hour will apply (maximum of \$25 per day). Non-validated tickets will incur normal casual parking rates of \$5 per hour (maximum of \$25 per day).
