# **COMPETITION OVERVIEW**

The tournament will be conducted in accordance with the Laws of Badminton as set out by the World Badminton Federation.

- Men's Competition Thomas Whalan Cup
- Women's Competition Liane Tooth Cup

## **TEAMS & REGISTRATION**

- Sydney Uni Sport will contact team captains regarding the number of registered players.
- If a residence has enough players for multiple teams, captains are responsible for team allocations before the competition.
- Each team must consist of 2 players.
- A match cannot start or resume if there are not two players per team on the court.

## **COMPETITION FORMAT**

- Each match consists of the best of three games.
- Each game shall be won by the team that first scores 21 points.
- A point is scored on every rally (rally scoring system).
- If the score reaches 20-20, a player must lead by two points to win.
- If the score reaches 29-29, the first to 30 wins the game.
- Matches will be in 30-minute time slots. If a match isn't over by the end of the 30 minutes, the team who is in the lead will be declared the winner.
- The draw will be created based on the number of registered teams.
- Once finalised, the draw will be available on the website and sent to team captains prior to the competition.
- While Badminton is a self-refereed competition, a court supervisor from Sydney Uni Sport will be present to adjudicate any contentious decisions.

# ALCOHOL POLICY

This is a DRY event – no alcohol is permitted. Anyone found consuming or in possession of alcohol will be asked to leave the event immediately.

## **PLAYER & SPECTATOR CONDUCT**

- Spectators must remain within designated areas for safety.
- All participants must adhere to Intramural and Sydney Uni Sport codes of conduct.
- Misconduct may result in removal from the venue and possible disciplinary action.
- Players must sign the Intramural Sport Waiver before participating.

## **FIRST AID**

- First aid will be available on-site.
- In case of a serious injury, please notify the Sydney Uni Sport convenor or residence representative immediately.

## **ADDITIONAL RULES**

- Teams must arrive at least 10 minutes before their scheduled start time.
- Equipment will be supplied and must be returned to the match official after each game.
- Residences must ensure the venue is cleaned and free of rubbish before leaving.

### **OVERALL WINNERS & INTRAMURAL POINTS**

Points accumulated throughout the year will contribute to the Intramural Championship standings. The residences with the highest points in both competitions (Thomas Whalan Cup & Liane Tooth Cup) will be recognised at the Intramural Gala Dinner.
