

OPERATING RULES

- 1. The event is conducted in accordance with the Intercollegiate Delegates Constitution, the following By-Laws and Australian Rugby Union rules as they apply in 2025.
- 2. Each game shall consist of 2 x 40min halves.
- In the case of conflict between the adopted rules and the Constitution or the Sporting By-Laws, The Constitution and Sporting By-Laws will have overriding authority.
- 4. The following additional rules also apply:
 - A. Any player being sent-off or otherwise having been mentioned in the referee's report shall automatically appear before the Intercol Tribunal.
 - B. A minimum of 6 players (3 on-field and 3 substitutions) are required to be suitably trained and experienced in the front row. Any College unable to provide the minimum requirements will be ineligible to contest scrums.
- Referees & two touch judges will be appointed per game by NSW Rugby Union.
- Participating colleges MUST provide 2 volunteers per game: 1x scorer and 1x ball collector

EVENT & VENUE INFO/CONDITIONS

Injuries, Accidents, Incidents

In the event of a serious injury, please notify Kirsty Stevens, an Intercol Committee rep, college sports rep, convenor or head of college immediately.

Alcohol Policy

- BYO and consumption of alcohol is NOT permitted at any of the University Ovals or on/within any other Sydney Uni Sport grounds and facilities.
- Please do not bring alcohol into any of the venues as it is not permitted. Persons found consuming or in possession of alcohol may be asked to leave immediately, by event and/or college staff. The exception is the Rugby Finals played at the SUFG where the following rules apply:

- A. As the SUFG Grandstand is a licensed venue, spectators cannot bring in their own alcohol. The Bar & Bistro will both be in operation for spectators to purchase food and drinks throughout the night.
- B. Individuals caught bringing their own beverages into the spectator areas will have them confiscated and may risk being evicted from the premises.
- C. Alcohol that is purchased from The Grandstand Bar & Bistro may be consumed within the licensed premises only and not taken away.
- D. Anyone deemed intoxicated will be asked to leave the premises.
- E. The SUFG is a smoke free venue, this includes vaping, anyone caught smoking will risk being removed from the premises.

Spectators

Please remain within the given spectator's area to ensure your own safety, as well as that of players and event staff/officials. All players and spectators are expected to abide by the Intercol and Sydney Uni Sport & Fitness codes of conduct. Misconduct will not be tolerated and offending persons may be asked to leave venues immediately and disciplinary action may follow.

Parking

No parking is available on-site for spectators at any of the venues. Cars may be used to deliver portable supplies before/after games.

Rubbish

All colleges must ensure that the venue is cleared of all rubbish on departure from the venues.

Conduct

All players and spectators are expected to abide by the Intercol code of conduct. Misconduct will not be tolerated and offending persons may be asked to leave venues immediately and disciplinary action will follow.
