COMPETITION OVERVIEW

- The tournament will be conducted in accordance with FIBA Official Basketball Rules. Each residence is eligible to enter teams in both of the following competitions:
- Men's Competition Thomas Whalan Cup
- Women's Competition Liane Tooth Cup

TEAMS & REGISTRATION

- Residences must register as a team to participate.
- Each residence may enter one team per competition.
 If additional teams are interested, please email
 intramural@sport.usyd.edu.au to express your interest.
 We will accommodate additional teams if space permits.
- Teams may consist of up to 12 players.
- Each team may have a maximum of 5 players on court at any time.
- A match cannot start or continue with fewer than 3 players on the court.
- Players may switch positions freely throughout the game.

COMPETITION FORMAT

- Matches consist of two 12-minute halves, with a 2-minute halftime break.
- Once finalised, the draw will be available on the website and sent to team captains prior to the competition.
- A continuous clock will run in the round games; however, the clock will be stopped and started in accordance with fouls in the final's rounds.
- Team Fouls
 - Each team is allowed 5 team fouls per half.
 - On the 6th foul and beyond, the other team is awarded one free throw for each foul.
- · No Player Fouling Out
 - Players will not foul out; however, repeated or rough fouls may result in:
 - · A warning from the referee, or
 - A short sub-off to reset and re-join later.
- In the event of team forfeits, a point deduction will apply, and team captains will need to consult the event coordinator for new fixtures.

SCORING SYSTEM

- Win = 3 points
- Draw = 2 points
- Loss = 1 point

Teams progressing to the finals (on the last day of competition) will be determined by round performance. If teams are tied on points, goal difference will be used as the tiebreaker.

OFFICIALS & CONDUCT

- · Referees' decisions are final.
- Abuse or misconduct directed at referees, players, or officials will not be tolerated and may result in ejection from the game.

ALCOHOL POLICY

This is a DRY event – no alcohol is permitted. Anyone found consuming or in possession of alcohol will be asked to leave the event immediately.

PLAYER & SPECTATOR CONDUCT

- · Spectators must remain within designated areas for safety.
- All participants must adhere to Intramural and Sydney Uni Sport codes of conduct.
- Misconduct may result in removal from the venue and possible disciplinary action.
- Players must sign the Intramural Sport Waiver before participating.

FIRST AID

- First aid will be available on-site.
- In case of a serious injury, please notify the Sydney Uni Sport convenor or residence representative immediately.

ADDITIONAL RULES

- · No rough play or unsportsmanlike conduct.
- Play to have fun, stay active, and include everyone.
- Teams must arrive at least 10 minutes before their scheduled start time
- Match balls will be supplied and must be returned to the match official after each game.
- Teams should wear matching uniforms with numbers where possible (bibs will be provided if necessary).
- Jewellery and piercings are not permitted for safety reasons.
- Residences must ensure the venue is cleaned and free of rubbish before leaving.

OVERALL WINNERS & INTRAMURAL POINTS

Points accumulated throughout the year will contribute to the Intramural Championship standings. The residences with the highest points in both competitions (Thomas Whalan Cup & Liane Tooth Cup) will be recognised at the Intramural Gala Dinner.
