OPERATING RULES FOR RAWSON CUP

1. The event shall be conducted in accordance with the Constitution, the following by-laws and FIFA rules as they apply in the year of competition.
2. In the case of conflict between the adopted rules and the Constitution or the Sporting By-Laws, the Constitution and Sporting By-Laws shall have over-riding authority.
3. The following additional rules are to be adhered to
 - Each game shall consist of 2 x 45min halves fully timed;
- 3.2 In the event of a drawn game, each team will receive one competition point.
- 3.3 Colleges may name a squad of up to 23 players for use throughout the competition.
- 3.4 A maximum of 16 players may be listed per game (11 starting players / up to 5 substitutes)
- 3.5 Teams are allowed 5 interchanges per half.
- 3.6 Players not taking part in the match may not be present in the technical area during matches.

OPERATING RULES FOR ROSEBOWL CUP

1. The event shall be conducted in accordance with the Constitution, the following by-laws and FIFA rules as they apply in the year of competition.
2. In the case of conflict between the adopted rules and the Constitution or the Sporting By-Laws, the Constitution and Sporting By-Laws shall have over-riding authority.
3. The following additional rules are to be adhered to:
 - Each game shall consist of 2 x 35min halves fully timed;
- 3.2 In the event of a drawn game, each team will receive one competition point.
- 3.3 Colleges may name a squad of up to 23 players for use throughout the competition.
- 3.4 A maximum of 16 players may be listed per game (11 starting players / up to 5 substitutes)
- 3.5 Teams are allowed 5 interchanges per half.
- 3.6 Players not taking part in the match may not be present in the technical area during matches.

COMPETITION FORMAT

4. Every College shall play each other according to the draw set out in section 1.6 and 2.6 of the Rawson and Rosebowl Rules

POINT SCORING

5. To determine the final result of the competition, the following points shall be awarded for each fixture.
6. (i) The winning College shall receive 2 points
(ii) Both Colleges shall receive 1 point for a tied match
(ii) The losing College shall receive 0 points
7. The final placings shall be awarded according to the aggregate of points accumulated by each College, as outlined in section 1.2 and 2.2 of the Rawson and Rosebowl Rules.

OFFICIALS

8. The appointment of suitably accredited Match Officials is the responsibility of SUSF as managers of the competition.

DUTIES OF CONVENOR

9. The Sydney Uni Sport Manager shall allocate duties in connection with the convenorship of each Rawson and Rosebowl sport.
